TEEN IDL Student Conduct Contract and Waiver

Certain standards are expected of students enrolling in distance education courses. This contract is intended to make students (and parents) aware of the standards expected of students enrolling in such courses.

Student/Parent Interactive Distance Learning Contract

As a student taking an interactive video course or participating in a learning situation, I am aware that:

- Certain standards are expected of me, as a student, and insubordination of any kind will not be tolerated. Insubordination has been defined as anything that interferes with teaching or learning in the classroom in the judgment of the teacher or facilitator of the course or meeting.
- Inappropriate language or gestures will not be tolerated.
- Anything being taught or that I do in the classroom can be videotaped by anyone at anytime.

Classroom procedures that must be followed are:

- Students must sit within camera view at all times.
- Students must not mishandle the equipment in the classroom.
- Students must follow all other rules as specified by the teacher and/or the facilitator.
- If technical problems occur the student is responsible to communicate to the teacher to gain access to the missed information and/or assignments.

As a Student/parent, I understand that if I/my child do(es) not abide by the above listed rules of participation, I/my child will be subject to the following discipline action(s), up to and including immediate dismissal from this class:

- **First Offense:** Verbal or written warning from instructor followed by parental notification of the infraction by written letter. Copies of the warning will be sent to parent(s)/guardian(s), principal, and placed in the student's records.
- **Second Offense:** The student will be removed from the class until such time a conference of parents/guardians, student, instructor and principal can be held and behavior(s) can be discussed.
- **Third Offense: (Ongoing and/or, severe misconduct and/or, damaging of TEEN/School equipment in any way) The student will removed from class and subject to loss, full, or partial credit or coursework.**

Student/Parent Waiver

I understand that in a Distance Learning Classroom my voice, physical presence, and participation in classroom activities will be transmitted to distance learning sites. I hereby agree that my voice, presence, and participation in these classes will not be a violation of my personal rights and hereby release any claims for the use of such during the duration of the distance learning class and the use of the videotapes for educational purposes during later classes or workshops.
