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## TEEN Virtual Academy Technology Usage Agreement/Computer Care Contract 2024-25

#### Adults 20 and Over (As of September 20, 2024)

- 1. Never share your passwords. You are accountable for all access to websites, computers, and technology for which you are assigned.
- 2. Treat all technology with respect. Do not vandalize any technology equipment. Deliberate attempts to degrade the computer networks or to disrupt system performance will result in disciplinary action.
- 3. Obey rules of copyright, trademark and license restrictions.
- 4. Avoid any technology activity, which is illegal or involves inappropriate language, pictures, or graphics. E-mail and all other forms of electronic communication are to be used in a responsible manner. Students may not use vulgar, derogatory, or obscene language.
- 5. Do not give out any personal information, anonymous, or false information on the Internet. Students should consult a parent if they are in question about sharing any information.
- 6. Class work is always the priority for virtual program issued computers. Students who are declared absent because of not completing work will be required to return the program issued laptop.
- 7. Students may not engage in personal attacks or harassment of others, and may not post information about other students or teachers online without their permission.
- 8. Students will not attempt to install any software, including file sharing programs.
- 9. Laptops are filtered for content at your home. Expect all email, files and/or web history to be subject to inspection by the TEEN Virtual Academy/home district whether on a school issued laptop or a personal laptop when logged into the student's district google account.
- 10. Report any inappropriate material immediately to the TEEN Virtual Academy.

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## Userscript and Bot Usage—Edgenuity Courses TEEN Virtual Academy Policy

A userscript is a program for modifying web pages to enhance browsing by adding shortcut buttons and keyboard shortcuts, controlling playback speeds, and so on. Students may use them to automate certain aspects of course completion. For example, a student may add a browser extension that attempts to click buttons or fill in fields in our system. In general, a userscript or bot is doing the work for the student automatically.

Edgenuity has implemented a userscript detection program. If Edgenuity detects userscript/bot usage the student will be logged out of Edgenuity and sent the message "Academic Integrity concern detected – you have been logged out of Edgenuity."

#### Consequences for Userscript Detection

First Offense: If a student account is flagged with a userscript logout from Edgenuity, all of the student's active classes will be reset back to the beginning of the units the student was working on when the userscript was detected. The student will have to redo all of the work for that unit in each of the active classes.

Second Offense: If the student account is flagged a second time, the student will be required to start all active classes over from the beginning of the coursework. If the student is not able to redo and finish a class before the semester deadlines, they will forfeit credit for that class and receive an F on their transcript.

Third Offense: If a student account is flagged a third time, the student will not be allowed to enroll in the next semester as a TEEN Virtual Academy student.
